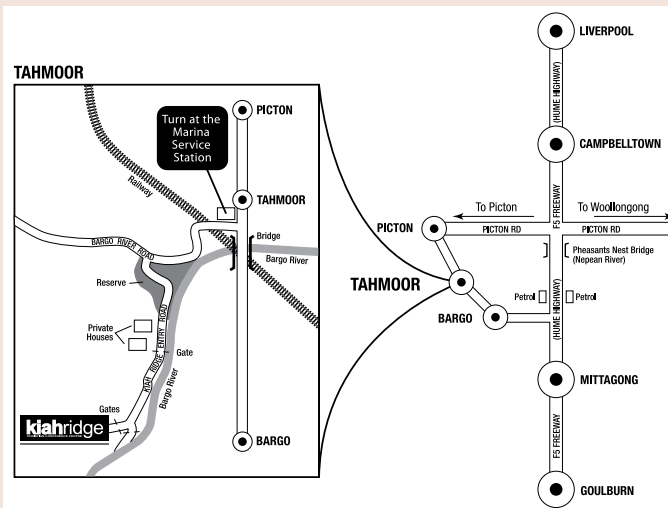
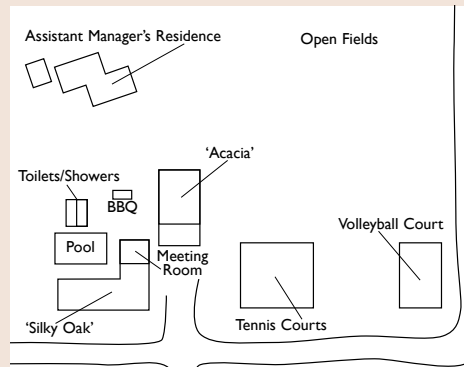

## How do I get there?

If travelling south, travel down the F5 Freeway/ Hume Highway until you get to Picton Road. Turn right and head toward Picton, then turn left at Argle Street. After ten kilometres, turn right at the service station down Bargo River Road. Turn left down Kiah Ridge Access Road until arrive at the gate

If traveling north, continue up the Hume Highway/ F5 Freeway and turn left at Remembrance Driveway.

## Where are we staying?
